ELIGIBILITY:

- **1.** Be of Hispanic/Latino heritage.
- Graduating or have graduated from a Greater Kansas
 City metropolitan area high school or obtain a general
 equivalency diploma (GED) from a local organization.
 (The Greater Kansas City metropolitan area is
 generally defined as Clay, Jackson,
 Platte, Johnson and Wyandotte counties.)
- 3. Attend or have attended a Greater Kansas City metropolitan area high school for the last three years prior to graduation.

- 4. Accepted or enrolled in a fully accredited college or university and working towards an associate, bachelor, or graduate degree.
- 5. Enroll or be enrolled as a full-time student. (A minimum 12 credit hours for undergraduate and 9 credit hours for graduate.)
- **6.** Select trade programs eligible for HDF Scholarship. For more information, contact Alejandra Perez.

EVALUATION:

- A. Proven academic merit as reflected in GPA and answer to essay question.
- B. Demonstrated need for financial assistance as exhibited by family's gross income, size of family and other financial need.
- C. Demonstrated community involvement as reflected in the application. Understanding the limited ability to perform community service this year, previous year's extracurricular activities and community service will be considered as well.
