The Johnson County Department of Health and Environment (JCDHE) will share information collected in the past year's Community Health Assessment and gather community members' perspectives on top priorities for future action. Each community meeting will be 75 minutes long and the same format - and will end with all attendees submitting their priorities for future action. Community input from all meetings will be compiled and provided to the Public Health Leadership Council, JCDHE's local steering committee, for final analysis and decision making for the 2025-2029 Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).

The input of Johnson County residents is essential to this process - your voices and priorities are critical to assuring that the CHIP reflects what this community identifies as most important to change or improve!
